Karim Errouaki holds a Ph.D. in Economics from the New School for Social Research (New York). He has taught and lectured in many parts of the world. He is Professor of International Finance, Money and Banking and President Emeritus of the American University of Europe (AUE-FON), Skopje, North Macedonia. He is a Senior Research Fellow at the Foundation Culture of Peace (affiliated with the Autonomous University of Madrid).

Errouaki has co-authored "Rational Econometric Man: Transforming Structural Econometrics" (Edward Elgar, London, 2013), with Prof. Edward Nell. (Nobel Laureate Prof. Lawrence Klein wrote the Preface). "Reinventing Globalization after the Crash" (forthcoming, Palgrave Macmillan, NY, 2020), is forthcoming, co-authored with Prof. Edward Nell and former DG of UNESCO Federico Mayor. (Former UN SG Boutros Boutros-Ghali, also a mentor of Errouaki, wrote the Introduction for the book before his sudden death and Nobel Laureate Professor Robert Mundell wrote the Preface). Also forthcoming is "Fundamentalism, Terrorism and Oil Reconsidered: From a Culture of Violence to a Culture of Peace", likewise co-authored with Edward Nell and Federico Mayor. Finally, "Hard Drugs and Easy Money", a study of the world-wide drug problem as a vicious cycle resulting from the interaction of cultural issues with economic pressures, will be forthcoming, also co-authored with Edward Nell and Federico Mayor.

Errouaki is a former Special Advisor to UNSG Professor Boutros Boutros-Ghali, and to Director General of UNESCO Professor Federico Mayor Zaragoza. He is Ambassador of the International Organization of Latin-American Mayors for Sustainable Development and Climate Change to the African Union and CAFRAD-Pan-African Intergovernmental Organization. He is Chairman of the US based Hedge Fund Titanium Capital llc.

Errouaki is currently a Special Advisor to the Central Bank Governor of the Republic Guinea-Conakry (BCRG): an assignment he handles in consultation with Professors Edward Nell, Robert Mundell, Willi Semmler, Charles Goodhart, Henry Abdo and Adam Nell in collaboration with former President Chief Olusegun Obasanjo of Nigeria, Mr. Baidy Aribot, Second Vice-Governor of BCRG and Dr. Paul Bangura. The team is working on the design, development and promotion of the ECOWAS common currency project, developing and rethinking a new financial architecture that might open up new paths of growth for the world economy.
